## *Classes Are Now in Session!*

**The PACMED Training Model** is designed to improve the transfer of knowledge from the trainer to the participants.

Included in the purchase price of a PACMED unit, staff from your pharmacy will receive initial training at McKesson APS.

For a fee, you also have the option to send new staff for training or to send staff for refresher training at a later date.



### **Controlled Environment**

The key to any kind of effective training is a controlled environment. Participants are able to focus their attention on the training without interruption, which greatly facilitates knowledge retention.

### **Practice Makes Perfect!**

The most important element when receiving training is to be able to put into practice what is being learned.

With McKesson APS' PACMED training, each participant will have access to a computer running the most recent version of PACMED Server +. This will enable all participants to experience the complete set of tasks involved in packaging.

The very nature of a controlled environment affords the trainer control over the training schedule, ensuring high quality training and that all points on the agenda are covered.
